The millet is the group of small seeded cereals belongs to family Graminae. It is domesticated and cultivated over 10000 years ago in Africa and then distributed throughout the world as human food. Excellent adaptability of this hardy crop group to adverse agro-climatic variations and low water requirement play an important role in agriculture. In semi-arid tropics in Africa and Asia made it as one of the ancient staple human foods. Even at present this group of crops showed their resistance to pests and diseases, short age, and better productivity especially under hardy and drought conditions when major cereals such as rice and maize cannot be relied upon to provide sustainable yield. Similarly, the millet group of crops do not demand higher production input such as inorganic fertilizer.

In Sri Lanka a number of different millets types such as Proso, Foxtail and Finger millets (varieties Oshadha and Rawana) have been grown and utilized for centuries. Of many millet types, finger millet (Kurakkan or Kurahan in Sinhala and Kezhvaraku in Tamil) plays a major role in the country. Though the present cultivation extent of millet reduces drastically due to open economy and government policies implemented to increase the food production in the country this staple grain has been able to assure food and nutrient security for Sri Lankans for many centuries while contributing to improving their health. Vitamin B, iron and calcium are rich in finger millet. It is also rich in dietary fiber providing an excellent remedy for constipation. It is low in fat content while rich in carbohydrate and make people healthy avoiding overweight. The slow digestion process of finger millet helps to lower the blood sugar among diabetic patients.

Hence it is obvious that paying attention to the cereal crops belonging to millet group directly impacting on the 5 sustainable development goals listed below, of the 17 declared by UN.

Goal 02: End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture

Goal 03: Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

Goal 12: Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns

Goal 13: Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts

Goal 15: Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and pause & reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss.

Hence, I am proud to mention that declaring "2023 the international year of Millet" by UN will give an opportunity to revisit and implement vital programme on cereal crop group Millet in the respective countries to meet the urgent environmental, political, and economic challenges facing in world to achieve sustainable growth policies.


